

Walton Park Easement

The Boone Conservancy maintains a one-acre conservation easement* along the stream within Walton Park in Walton, KY. The easement is home to several species of native plants including Swamp Milkweed, Common Milkweed, Cardinal Flower, Purple Cone Flower, and Rough-Leaved Sunflower. Efforts to continuously restore and maintain this natural area are currently underway as TBC and its volunteers plant native species and rid the area of non-native, invasive species.



*Conservation Easement: a legally binding agreement that limits certain types of uses or prevents development from taking place on the land in perpetuity while the land remains in private hands. Conservation easements protect land for future generations while allowing owners to retain many private property rights and to live on and use their land, at the same time potentially providing them with tax benefits (The Nature Conservancy. www.nature.org)
